- Day 1-4 Travel to **Keystone, South Dakota**
- Day 5 We have a full day of touring with a local guide: **Mt. Rushmore, Crazy Horse Memorial, and Custer State Park.**
- Day 5 Our destination today is **Great Falls, Montana.** The scenery is awesome as we travel through Big Sky Country.
- Days 7-9 We head north to **Calgary, Alberta, Canada** for a three night stay. Time for the **Calgary Stampede!** The entire city puts on their boots and hats for this celebration of Western hospitality and fun. Parades, rodeo action, chuck wagon racing, rides, shows, exhibits, music, and fireworks are all part of the Legendary Calgary Stampede.
- Day 10 Out travels today take us through the beautiful **Canadian Rockies.** The **Banff-Jasper Highway**, known as the Icefield Parkway, carries us through the majestic mountains and the **Columbia Icefield.** We will also see the breathtaking **Lake Louise** and the **Athabasca Glacier.** Our overnight is in Jasper.

- Day 14 **Yellowstone National Park!** A guide joins us today as we explore this one-of-a-kind natural wonder. Thermal features, including the **Old Faithful Geyser**, wildlife, and amazing scenery are ours to enjoy.
- Day 15 We will exit Yellowstone through the East Entrance. This is another very scenic drive! The **Buffalo Bill Historical Center in Cody, Wyoming** will be a stop today. This museum celebrates the spirit of the American West with art, history, culture, nature, and firearms. We travel on to **Thermopolis, WY** for our overnight.
- Days 16-18 **Frontier Days in Cheyenne, Wyoming!** We will be a part of the world’s largest outdoor rodeo and Western celebration. All the details have not been published, but we will have a great time enjoying all the fun Frontier Days has to offer. This city is **TOPS** in making sure motorcoach groups are given special attention.
- Days 19-20 Travel Home.
