Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, New York
September 20 – October 2, 2012

- Days 1-4 Travel through the picturesque countryside of the North East and arrive in **Meredith, NY** for a beautiful train ride along the shores of **Lake Winnepesaukee**.
- Day 5 Depart for touring: **Franconia Notch Visitor's Center and the Loon Gondola**. Ride to the top of the mountain for spectacular views of White Mountains of NH. Travel to **Bar Harbor, Maine** to check into the **Bluenose Inn**. It is a very special 4 Diamond – AAA rating! The rooms are in the classic "**Stenna Nordica**" building featuring excellent views of the harbor and Frenchman Bay. Enjoy outdoor or indoor pools, jacuzzi, steam room, and fitness center. Gather in the "Great Room" with plush furnishings and fireplace just to relax and chat. You will have time for some shopping at the sea side resort town before dinner. **Old -fashioned Down East Lobstah & Clambake** with all the fix-ins at the Inn for dinner tonight.
- Day 6 After breakfast, meet local guide at **Acadia National Park – Mount Desert Island**. Learn about the integral part the **Rockefellers** played in this park and enjoy views from the top of **Cadillac Mountain**. Learn about the true meaning of being lobstermen in Maine on the **Lobstah Boat Tour**. Shopping and browsing downtown later in the day.
- Day7 Depart for **Ellsworth, Maine to Timber Tina's Lumber Jack Show**. Watch Timber Tina and Her crew compete in this amazing and amusing chopping and stripping logs showdown. Lunch and shopping at **Farmington**. Check into **Jordan Grand Hotel**, Bethel, Maine. The Jordan Grand is located at the base of Sunday River Ski Resort, surrounded by mountain views in the heart of Maine's forest and mountain. Features include steam room, sauna, heated pool, and outdoor hot tub. A guided "**Moose Safari**" to look for these gentle giants often seen at dusk in Maine and NH woods will be a highlight of this day.
- Day 8 Depart for Vermont. Learn about **Bumpus Mines**, which produced some of the largest Beryls ever. See **Quechee Gorge, Woodstock, Covered Bridges, Quechee Gorge Village – A Vermont Sampler – Antique Mall**, Cabot Cheese, Danforth Pewter, Glass Blowing, Frozen Memories Ice Cream Shop, and Country Store. Overnight at Greenbrier Inn, Killington, Vermont.
- Day 9 We are off to the **New England Maple Museum** – to learn the history of maple sugaring. **Vermont Marble Museum, Rutland** will be our last stop before leaving Vermont for New York. **Cooperstown, NY**. We will overnight two nights at Bayside Inn & Marina, located on the shores of **Otsego Lake**.
- Day 10 A local guide will take us to the **National Baseball Hall of Fame & Museum**, Cooperstown shopping area, and a stop by the **Bat Factory Store** to order a specialized bat. Our lunch today will be at the Grand "**Otsego Hotel**" on Otsego Lake. After lunch more exploring of the Cooperstown area.
- Day 11-13 Travel Home.
