After an hour at the fort, we will cruise back to port, enjoying panoramic views of the Atlantic Ocean and Charleston's bustling harbor.

After leaving Charleston, we will step back in time and hear the stories of the beginning of Myrtle Beach, taking in such sites as **The Pavilion and Pawley's Island**, home of the famous hammocks. We will tour the low country, hearing the stories of the rice plantation and the ghosts that call the region home, travel the road George Washington traveled while visiting the area and hear the history of **Brookgreen Gardens** and the numerous fishing villages that dot the coastline. Also in this tour will be some of the great entertainment that Myrtle Beach is famous for, such as the spellbinding and magical "**Le Grand Cirque Animation**", featuring more than 40 champion acrobats and performers from Brazil, Canada, Russia, Mongolia, Europe and China, with feats of strength and incredible skill that will quite simply take your breath away. **The Palace Theatre**, featuring "The Magic of Ireland", blending the lifting melodies of the Irish Tenors with the heart-pounding, raw energy of the world renowned **Spirit of the Dance dancers** in an incredible new production, and **The Alabama Theatre**, celebrating over a decade of entertaining America, brings you "One" The Show.

As with all of our trips, we will dine at some of the areas favorite restaurants, including the **Crab House**, the restaurant that has been "flipped", and **A. W. Shuck's**, serving some of the finest seafood in Charleston. In Myrtle Beach we will eat at **Preston's Seafood and Country Buffet**, whose buffet features Alaskan King Crab Legs, Oysters, Salmon, Mahi, Prime Rib, yeast rolls, cakes and cobblers and a fantastic dessert selection, and **T-Bonz Steakhouse**, a local favorite, specializing in juicy, tender steaks and fresh seafood.
